The former Cypress Packers, located 7 miles south of Medicine Hat on paved Range Road # 63 is a 6,200 sq. ft. metal clad building with metal roof and all the operational requirements to resume production.

The building has walk-in coolers and a walk-in freezer, a high pressure water system, and another potential dehydrator. Water is from a well on site with the option to hook up with city water from a recently installed water line to the property. It is situated on 7 acres of land zoned for

agriculture which allows plenty of room for storage containers, future expansion, and other possibilities.
