It seems like the first month of production has been like trying to keep up with a runaway train. We have received approximately 20 tons of fresh and frozen vegetables for processing and have had anywhere from 3 to 28 volunteers show up per day to help with the work. One such volunteer is a friend all the way from India, Benjamin Yejjala – Founder of Bridge of Hope, a ministry providing medical, educational and feeding programs. Struggling to feed 850 children a day, he was shocked at the abundance of culled food yet pleased to see the efforts to capture as much as possible for food aid. Perhaps Prairie Gleaners product will go to India.
